




Measurements

Tips, Tricks, + Instructions

- We find that grid paper is easiest to work with, making each square the equivalent of 1'. If you don't have grid paper, no worries! Regular computer paper works, too. We're not looking for perfection.
- Draw the outline of the room. We recommend using a pencil.
- Moving clockwise around the room, mark the general location of any architectural features (windows, doors, fireplace, built-in bookshelf, etc.).
- Mark the approximate location of outlets, vents, and other permanent items.
- Now start taking measurements. Use feet and inches to the nearest quarter of an inch.
- Measure the width and length of each wall don't worry about those architectural features yet, just the totals.
- Measure the height of the ceiling.
- Now you'll go back to get specific measurements for each architectural feature.
- Measure from the outside of the trim on architectural features for consistency.
- You will upload a photo or scan of your drawing in your Design Questionnaire.





Photos

Tips, Tricks, + Instructions

- Take photos during the day, whenever the room gets the most sunlight.
- Natural light is best! Turn off your flash as well as any light fixtures in the room.
- Do a quick tidy up of the space before taking photos.
- Stand in each corner and against each wall, working your way clockwise around the room, taking a photo from each angle.
- Lower your camera. It keeps the focal point of any room more squared off and resembles the room from a seated position.
- Include part of the floor and part of the ceiling in the frame of each photo for reference.
- Now go back and photograph anything you want to keep in the room, such as pieces of furniture.
- You will upload these photos in your Design Questionnaire.

What to Expect

Prep Work

Once we receive your request for the service we will initiate your invoice. We will have a 45 minute Zoom meeting where we discuss your project needs.

Beforehand you will be sent a Design Questionnaire to gather all the information we will need to be as effective and efficient as possible during our session time. We require receipt of all photos, measurements, and inspiration images at least 48 hours before your Zoom session.

Please submit these via the instructions in your Design Questionnaire. The more information you can provide, the better!

The Design & Deliverables

Once we've completed our Zoom session we can begin pulling your design together. Our goal is in a single 6 hour day to help problem solve, create beautiful solutions for your home and provide an easy to follow road map of how to implement this design in your own timing. We will be sourcing from various retailers, and will do our best to select items that are in stock.

In 3 business days you will receive a beautifully designed PDF packet with Material Selections, Design Selection Mockup, Retail Shopping Lists, and Conclusion Notes.



FAQ

Can I order trade only items?

"Trade", or better know as designer only products are reserved for our full service clients. Product sourced through trade vendors require our full attention and communication-ordering, tracking, warehouse receiving, and product installation (hence this becomes full service). In an effort to keep this offering at a more approachable price point we will be sourcing from retailers that you know and love. You can order and implement at your own pace.

How many sessions can I book?

We allow a maximum of three Designer for a Day per project. If you feel you will need additional help for your home, please consider Full Service Design.

How much will we cover?

We recommend focusing the project on just 1-2 rooms or topics, so we can provide you with the expertise needed to achieve your design. The more information you provide to us in advance - including photos, measurements, and a thoughtfully completed Design Questionnaire - the more we can cover.

Can I add to my project?

We love repeat clients! When you're ready to tackle another room or project in your home, we invite you to book another Designer for a Day session. If, after your session, you decide you would like us to be a larger part of your project, or if your project is larger than you initially expected, we'd be happy to provide you with a proposal for Full Service Design.
